

New Appointment System success - Thanks to You!

The Surgery has moved to a system where all appointment requests are triaged by a doctor and patients are encouraged to make requests via an online form on the Surgery's website wherever possible. Most patients are now making appointment requests online, which has eased the pressure on the phone line and resulted in the call waiting time reducing by around 80% on what it was a year ago. This helps all patients contacting the Surgery.

NHS

Get your free NHS flu jab if you're eligible

Do all you can to keep yourself well during winter.



Whilst our large, dedicated flu clinics have finished for the year, those who are eligible for an NHS flu jab can still book in for an appointment with a member of the nursing team to receive this!

You're eligible for free NHS flu vaccine if:

- You are aged 65 or over (including those who will be 65 by 31 March 2026)
- You have certain long-term health conditions
- You are pregnant
- You live in a care home
- You are the main carer for an older or disabled person, or receive a carer's allowance
- You live with someone who has a weakened immune system
